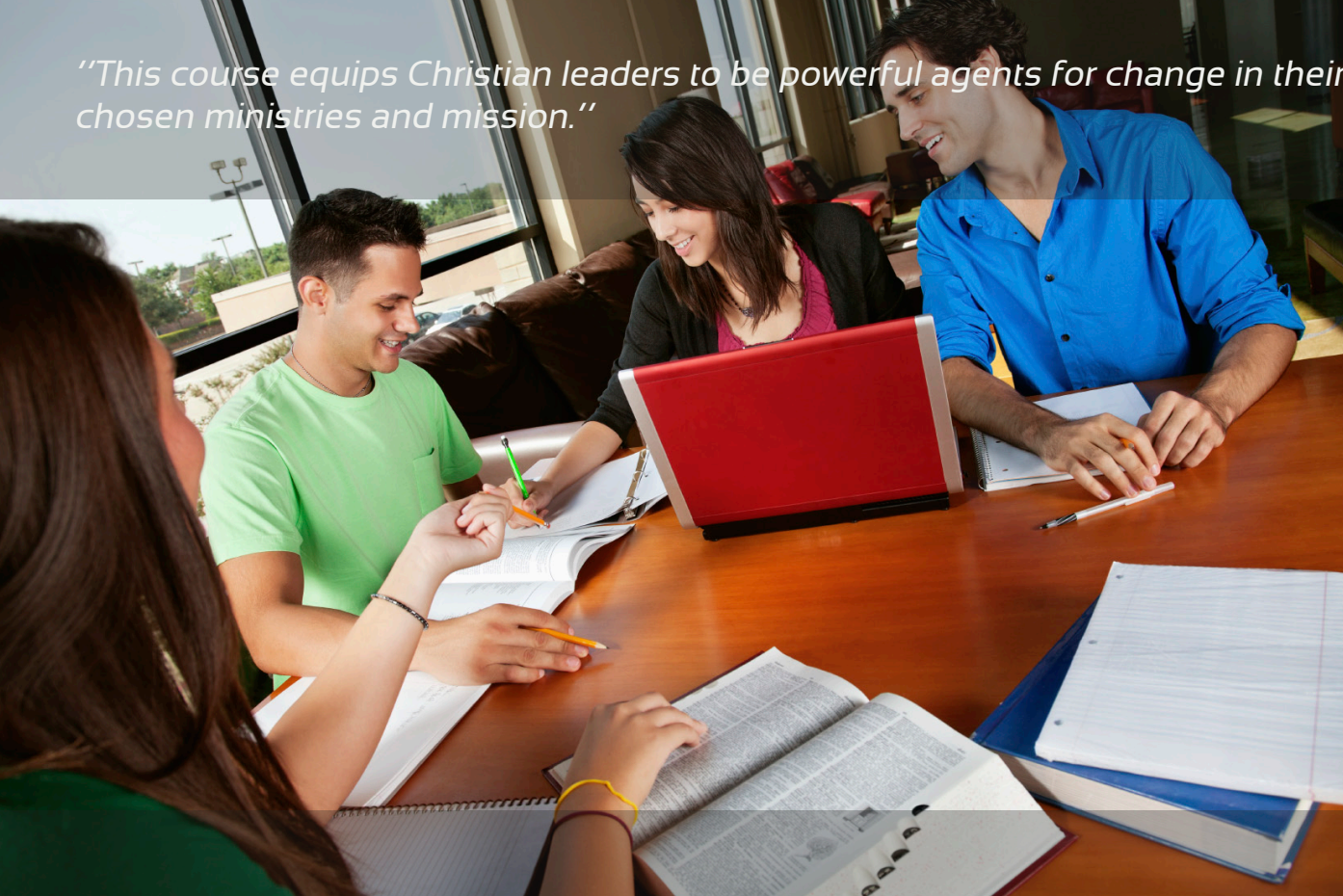

Course Information

The **Master of Arts** is a high quality professional development program for students wanting to update or upgrade their leadership capacities, missional orientation and ability to relate to emerging post-modern cultures.

The degree resources and provides professional development to anyone in a Christian leadership position, and particularly focuses on building skills and capacities leading to the growth of churches and other ministries.

Course Structure

The **Master of Arts** comprises of 12 subjects with a 'nested' Graduate Certificate in Arts (4 subjects) and Graduate Diploma in Arts (8 subjects).

The program is offered by distance education supported by optional facilitations (3 day study support sessions) with some of Australia's and the world's leading scholars and practitioners acting as facilitators. Distance education allows students to remain in mission and ministry while they earn their postgraduate award.

We aim to balance the benefits of face-to-face student support with the flexibility of external study. We operate a "no campus" training model which means you study in your own space, at your own pace. A subject package is delivered to your door containing all of the materials you will need to successfully complete each subject. We are also firm believers in the value of face-to-face interaction. For this reason our subjects are offered with 3-day facilitations where students gather with a trained facilitator to discuss the subject content and apply it to everyday life.

Facilitations are optional, providing maximum flexibility to those who need it. However our students find facilitations to be extremely valuable experiences and they are highly recommended.

A **3-year** undergraduate degree or equivalent is required to enrol.
